New Zealand

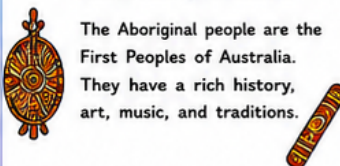
- Two main islands: North Island and South Island.
