

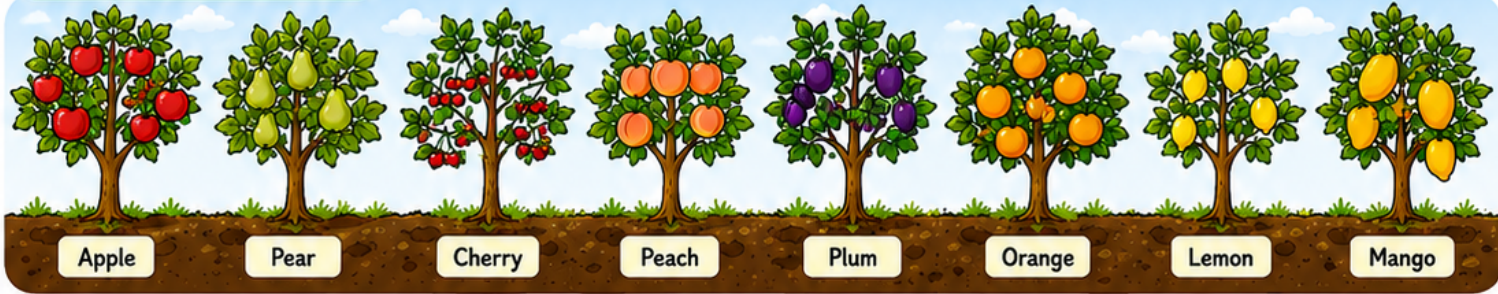

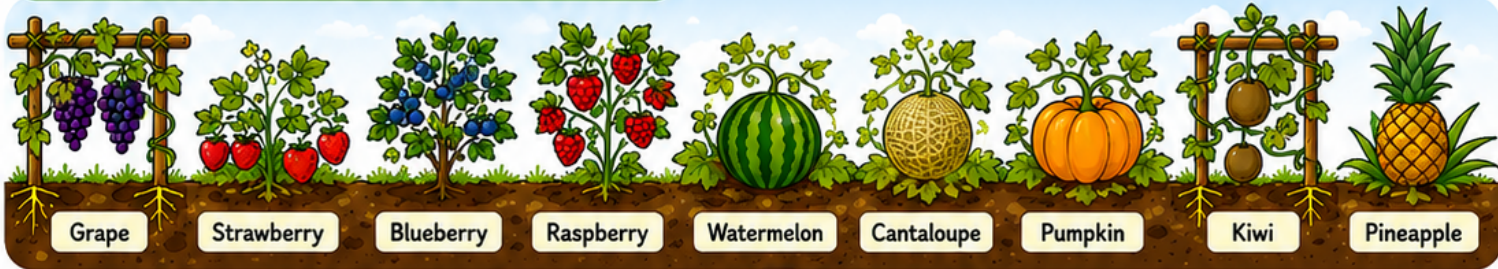
How Do Fruits Grow?

Fruits grow on different parts of plants above the ground.

Fruits That Grow on Trees



Fruits That Grow on Vines, Bushes, or Small Plants



Why do these fruits grow above the ground?



• They need sunlight and fresh air



• Their flowers are above the ground



• Their fruits stay dry and warm



• Animals can see, eat, and share the seeds



Vines and stems grow on or above the ground to reach the light
